The dance will be held at a venue off campus. The attire for the evening is semi-formal/formal. Please keep in mind that this is a school sponsored event. Therefore, make sure that the attire is not too short, tight, or revealing. Ladies: see-through and attire showing excessive amounts of skin- predominately below the shoulders and above the knee will not be tolerated. Dress code violations will be turned around at the door. Parents will not be allowed to escort their children inside. Please plan to drop students off at the venue (no parents/guardians are allowed to attend).
